The tuition charges listed are based on Wisconsin residency plus an adjustment for tuition charges from the host institution. Minnesota residents still must add reciprocity. Residents of other states add non-resident fees as follows: \$250 for 3 credits; \$500 for 6 credits; \$750 for 9 credits: \$1000 for 12 - 18 credits.

Financial Aid: If you receive financial aid, **only the costs you pay to UWSP will be automatically paid from your aid.** If you receive more aid than what you need to pay to UWSP, you will receive a refund. You are responsible for paying all other costs directly to third party program services provider.

If you find that required transportation costs or personal expenses are higher than the estimate, these costs may be added to your financial aid budget.
